





The Real God

The Real God is a study designed to help you see God as He truly reveals Himself in Scripture. Many of the struggles we face come from misunderstandings about who God is. This series explores seven core attributes of God's character, addressing common misconceptions and replacing them with the truth of His goodness, love, and holiness. As you grow in your understanding of who God really is, you will find your faith strengthened and your relationship with Him deepened.

The Practices: Fasting and Solitude

This class focuses on two deeply formative practices that draw us closer to God in real and practical ways. Fasting invites us to integrate our whole selves—body, mind, and spirit—into seeking God with greater dependence and clarity. Solitude mirrors the rhythm of Jesus, who regularly withdrew from the noise to be with the Father so He could return to community in love and strength. In this class, we will learn about these practices and also experience them together. Understanding is important, but practice is where transformation begins.

Promised Land

Promised Land brings Scripture to life by exploring major themes from Exodus through Judges. Through beautifully produced dramatizations, you will hear key passages narrated by actors portraying biblical figures such as Moses, Aaron, Joshua, Caleb, and Deborah. Each session places the biblical story in its cultural, social, and geographic context, widening your understanding of God's work among His people. This series helps you see the Old Testament with fresh eyes and invites you to know God more deeply through His unfolding story of redemption.
